There were balloons, cake and juice drinks to celebrate the birthdays of 24 children whose birthdays fell in the months of July through September. Rotarians from the Long Neck Sunrise Rotary Club were on hand to present \$25 Visa gift cards and a balloon to each child whose birthday was being celebrated.



"We are so grateful to have this partnership with the Long Neck Sunrise Rotary Club," noted current Club Director Erica Kennedy. "The Club began this project last year and we are so happy they are able to continue with it. The children really look forward to having this special day."

Originally part of a district grant program procured by the Long Neck Sunrise Rotary Club to Celebrate the Lives of Youngsters at the Oak Orchard Boys & Girls Club, the program now is being run with proceeds from the Club's annual golf outing held in June each year at The Peninsula Golf Club. Every month between September 2018 and May 2019, the Long Neck Sunrise Rotary Club will hold a party for those

children with birthdays falling between July 2018 and June 2019. The Club expects to celebrate the birthdays of 100-110 young people during the coming months.

provided dictionaries annually to the third graders attending Long Neck Elementary School as well as supported the annual book fair at Long Neck Elementary.

The Long Neck Sunrise Rotary Club has developed this birthday program with the belief that celebrating another person's uniqueness, helps to develop social and emotional learning, which is the cornerstone of maintaining healthy, interpersonal relationships.
