- 1) A transcript of the applicant's academic record;
- 2) At least one letter of recommendation from a teacher or other advisor/adult inside or outside the school that can provide an evaluation of the applicant's service to their school and community, potential for leadership and scholastic achievements;
- 3) A letter written by the applicant stating the reasons why he/she plans to attend College, Business School or Technical School and how that experience benefits their future;
- 4) An acceptance letter from the College, Business School or Technical School.
