INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING

Your application must include the following components and be submitted via **email** following the instructions below:

Please be sure to have your name on each file that you include in your email submission.

- 1) A completed “Morse Home Improvement Building Trades” Scholarship Application: Complete Forms A, B, and C on this application electronically by saving to your computer hard drive first, and then fill out the required fields. If you do not have any information for a required field, type “NA”. Be sure to save the application with your name added to the file name. If you need to add extra pages, you can create them within any software program and save as a PDF or in the original file format, making sure the file name has the proper description and contains your name. The Scholarship Application allows for electronic signature for you and your parent(s), but you can also print and sign the “Morse Home Improvement Trades” Scholarship application by scanning the application, saving as a pdf with your name added to the file name.
- 2) A transcript of your academic record with a GPA of “C” or higher.
- 3) At least one letter of recommendation from a teacher or other advisor/adult in or out of school that can provide an evaluation of your construction trade interests and/or skills.
- 4) A letter of intent for a Trade School or Apprenticeship Program
- 5) Submit **ALL** application materials to: Judy Hall, jandmhall1227@gmail.com. Include in your email a cover letter, including a listing of the attachments being sent and their file names.
