ABOUT LONG NECK SUNRISE ROTARY CLUB

The Long Neck Sunrise Rotary Club was chartered on August 27, 2010. Before chartering, club members had already initiated this golf tournament as the keystone of our annual fundraising efforts to support local and international charitable initiatives, donating over \$176,000 since 2010.

From these humble beginnings, we have many proud accomplishments, including the following highlights:

- Sponsoring 31 students to Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) weekends.
- Annually awarding Service Above Self Scholarships to seniors graduating from Sussex Central High School. This year we will be awarding four \$2,000 scholarships
- Contributing \$10,000 to the construction of a new playground at Long Neck Elementary School.
- Contributing \$1500 for books and activity packets for all Long Neck Elementary School students during the COVID lockdown.
- Contributing over \$15,000 in book purchases at cost from our partner Browse-about Books for our Rotary Reads Program.
- Holding MLB Pitch Hit & Run Competitions with youngsters at the Oak Orchard Boys & Girls Club.
- Conducting monthly Birthday Parties replete with cupcakes and gift cards for young people and staff at the Oak Orchard Boys & Girls Club.
- Contributing over \$11,000 in musical instruments for the band program at Sussex Academy in a joint project with Rehoboth Beach Sunrise Rotary Club
- International Sponsor/Participant Club for Global Grants to purchase medical equipment for cataract surgeries and to purchase cows to establish women farmers in India.
- Developed water sources and 150 family sanitation facilities for Nalerigu, Ghana and to drill wells in the Democratic Republic of Congo-Miriam's Table.
- Our annual Flags for Heroes program runs each year during the two weeks surrounding Veteran's Day and enables our club to support worthy programs for veterans and their families.
